- Read - Staff notation
- Read - in varying clefs (later in the year)
- Transposition!

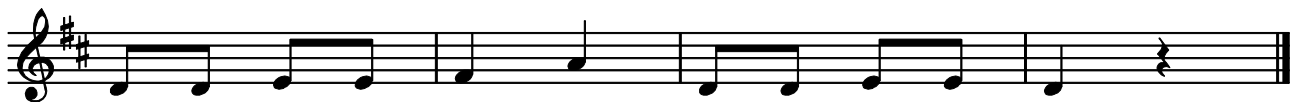
